As we build on the deep foundations of faith laid by the countless saints of these Northern lands,

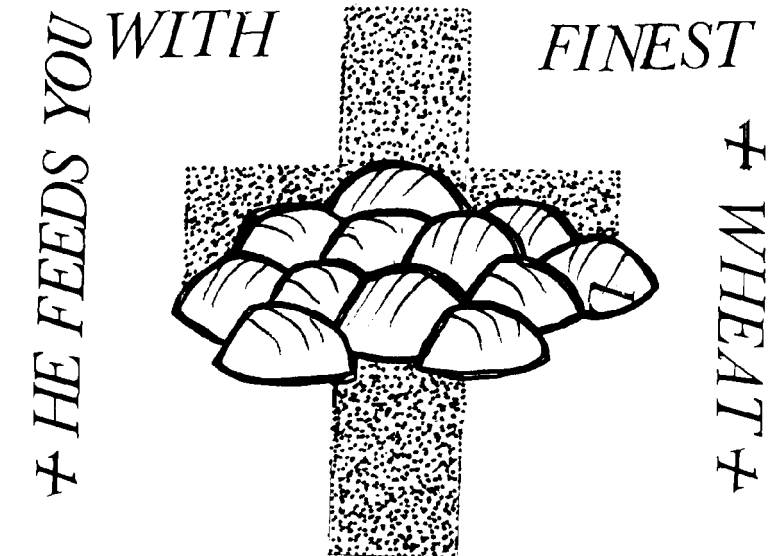
by Aidan and Cuthbert, Hilda and Bede,
