Jesus sends them in pairs, establishing his mission as a communal endeavour. Jesus also instructs them to travel lightly, without food, money, or extra sets of clothes. These instructions mean that the Twelve will be dependent on the hospitality of others, just as Jesus depended on others to provide for his needs. Jesus continues to send us into the world as his disciples, but like the first disciples, we are not sent alone. Jesus has given us the community of the Church, which strengthens our life of discipleship. The Christian message can be proclaimed in and through the community of faith that is the Church. In our work with others, we build this community of faith and can invite others to share in it

Go tell everyone! Dear Lord, help me to continuously be aware of all people around me every single day. Where there are people, there are needs. Give me Your eyes to see some of those needs and the wisdom to know how to help as well. Help me to be your hands and feet as I serve others right where I'm at.
