Jesus always took the time to teach that all of life is under the direction of God. Everything we do should be seen in light of God's activity in the world. We cannot remove ourselves from God's presence, so all of our life is lived within that presence. Jesus points out that through resurrection we are sharing in the divine life of God.

The Church sets aside November, which begins with All Saints Day and All Souls Day, as the Month of the Holy Souls. In November we are encouraged to pray for those who have gone before us, family and friends and for those who may have no one to pray for them. In this way we are joined to others in the Christian family and reminded that we are a wider community united in our belief in Jesus and his Resurrection. Pope St John XXIII wrote the following words "The devotion to the memory of the dead is one of the most beautiful expressions of the Catholic spirit."

Thank you for the remembrance of loved ones no longer with us; for their inspiring words, encouragement, love and support, an example for us to follow. May their legacy be seen in the people we have become, and may we always be thankful.
