In today's Gospel, the voice from heaven speaks to the disciples saying, "*Listen to him.*" The Transfiguration was a focused moment for the disciples when they heard God speaking to them and experienced Jesus in glory. They left the mountain with a new appreciation for the importance of Jesus' words, even if they did not yet understand everything that he had taught them. During Lent, we are invited to consider our attentiveness to Jesus and to one another. In the pace and noise that often characterises life, we need to find time for quiet prayer.

At the Transfiguration, Father, You showed Jesus in glory, a glimpse of what His disciples would see in His risen life. Bless us in our humanity with an awareness of Your presence, leading us to share in Your divine life, even in our daily struggle.
