In this Sunday's gospel Jesus made it clear that it was a particular grace from God which allowed Peter, from among all the apostles and disciples, to discern His true identity. Peter announced his belief that Jesus was the promised Messiah. Jesus was much more than a prophet, and Peter was divinely inspired to acknowledge this truth. For Peter it was his faith in Jesus, the Son of God. This would keep him going all of his life, even at times of unfaithfulness and danger, he could never forget that he had said, 'You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God.' He was called because of his relationship with Jesus Christ, the one who calls forth our faith and love and gives our lives a huge meaning.

Lord, source of eternal life and truth, give to Your shepherd, Pope Francis, a spirit of courage and right judgement, By governing with fidelity those entrusted to his care may he, as successor to the apostle Peter and Vicar of Christ, build Your church into a sacrament of unity, love and peace for all the world. Amen.

**New Lectionary to be launched in England and Wales for Advent 2024 . . .** The Dicastery for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments has confirmed the approval by the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales for the new Lectionary. The Lectionary, which includes the scripture readings for Mass and the Sacraments, will come into use in Catholic parishes in England and Wales from Advent 2024.
