May, the Month of Our Lady ~ This month we can seek to understand more deeply, the pivotal role that the Blessed Mother played and continues to have in the unravelling of Salvation History. It is a month, too, in which we can intentionally focus on loving Our Lady as our true Mother just as Jesus intends us too. While he hung upon the Cross, He spoke those precious words which continue to reach out across the millennia to our own time and, in a very personal way, to our own hearts, "Behold your Mother". When we give ourselves to her and allow her to teach and guide us, we can more effectively be her hands and feet in bringing others to Jesus. We will be better able to make Jesus known to the world at large because that is what Our Lady does.

This Sunday marks the 62nd anniversary of the World Day of Prayer for Vocations.
