In this Sunday's Gospel Jesus suggests that we would be better to identify with the tax collector and present ourselves in humility before God and before those with whom we share our lives. Jesus reminds us that our faith is about our humble response to God who has given us everything in Christ. True humility helps us to see ourselves as we really are in God's eyes and it leads us to seek God's help and mercy. God dwells with the humble of heart who recognize their own sinfulness and who acknowledge His mercy and saving grace.



Next Sunday, on the Feast of All Saints, we welcome Stewart Bell, Jessica Moore and Ian Railton into full communion with the Catholic Church. They invite you to join them in the Parish Hall following Mass for cake and refreshments. All welcome, please remember them in your prayers.

Each year an appeal is made to support the Clergy Training Fund in response to the ever-increasing costs of training priests and deacons to serve in our diocese. There is no state funding for seminaries or for the formation of permanent deacons and so the money required to provide each student with accommodation, living costs and tuition for a number of years needs to be found from the generous support of people who contribute to this fund. Following ordination, priests and deacons give back many decades of service, providing the presence of Christ in our communities. **There will be a second collection this Sunday** for the Priests Training Fund. The collection remains open and contributions invited until 23rd November.
