The third Sunday of Advent is called "Gaudete" Sunday, it is a time of joy, a time of being thankful for all that has been given, the promise of the Saviour who has come, who is present and who promises a return. Advent is a time of waiting. John the Baptist has been patiently waiting for the Messiah and sends messengers to ask Jesus if He is the One he has been waiting for. Jesus replies that the people should look at the signs of healing, raising from the dead and the bringing of the Good News. Jesus is the fulfilment of the prophets. The message of Advent is that we should wait patiently for the Lord to come into our lives. This can be a time of enrichment, He is present to us in Word and Sacrament, but He is also present to us in the words and gestures of other people.

You are warmly invited to attend our 'Carols Around the Tree' service on Wednesday 17th December 2025 in church at 17:00. The children will tell the Nativity story through scripture readings, liturgical dance and with the singing of Christmas carols. Seasonal refreshments will be available in the school hall afterwards.
